Scheduled Preventive Maintenance Program*:

AIR CONDITIONING

- Replace and/or adjust belts
- Check for refrigerant and oil leaks
- Visually inspect heat exchanger and pipes
- Inspect and clean condensate pans, P-traps, and drain lines
- Chemically clean and flush evaporator and condenser coils
- Remove and clean heat pipe if applicable
- Check and adjust outside air damper economizer
- Check and/or tighten electrical connections
- Check for proper grounding and test fuses
- Lubricate fan motors and bearings; clean blower wheel
- Check crankcase heaters and rain shields
- Clean and inspect fan blower
- Check safety switches for compressor

THERMOSTAT

- Measure and record temperatures of air supply and return
- Check and reset thermostat settings

HEATING

- Start and check all heating units and ignition systems
- Inspect burners, check for gas leaks
- Inspect heat exchanger, pilot, orifices, and gas valves

REFRIGERATION

- Walk-in coolers and freezers, upright freezers
- Over- or under-counter reach-in refrigerators
- Point-of-use areas, make-tables, retarders, salad bars
- Ice makers, drink station ice machines
